<p>This affects Refine current rule Add categories to rule as well as Add ranges to rule.</p> <p>If you use an expression such as COL1/COL2 to create a classification, the resulting rule will be, e.g. "COL1/COL2" >= 0 AND "COL1/COL2" <= 10</p> <p>There are actually two errors here:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. QGIS cannot find a column "COL1/COL2" and therefore won't draw the rule.2. The rules overlap because they are always generated using >= and <= rather than > and <=.
