<p>Hi!</p> <p>Win7sp1 x64, qgis dev x64 rev. commit:18df003</p> <p>In Settings/Options/General I set "Timeout for timed messages or dialogs" as 2 sec., but when I try to save edits on postgis layer each time appears at the top of the screen message, that doesn't disappear - I must turn it off manually - and it occurs each time I save edits - and in postgis layers everything is ok - edits are saved etc.</p> <p>You can see that on that video, but download that and watch locally on computer, as dropbox player reduces resolution:</p> <p><a href="https://www.dropbox.com/s/qzjzie8pk158296/clip2.mp4?dl=0">https://www.dropbox.com/s/qzjzie8pk158296/clip2.mp4?dl=0</a></p> <p>In qgis dev x64 rev. commit:4cdf05f there was no such bug (the same qgis project, postgis layers etc.)</p>
