<p>The function "Check QGIS version" reports the most current version as <i>2.10.1</i>, but it should be <i>2.12.0</i>. This is due to an outdated <a href="https://qgis.org/version.txt">https://qgis.org/version.txt</a> that does not reflect the release of version 2.12.0.</p> <p>I suggest to automate the process of retrieving the current version. It is usually as easy as going to <a href="https://qgis.org/">https://qgis.org/</a> and looking in the top left corner.</p>
