Description On Windows with QGIS 2.10 or 2.12 (2.8?) there is a big bug when we delete a feature. The data associated with this object is not deleted from the .shp file. 1) Create a new Shapefile (ponct). 2) Create 3 points 3) Delete the 2th point. The .dbf contains 2 rows (it's ok) but the file "*.shp" is strictly the same as before the deletion. 'ogrinfo -ro -so -al test_qgis.shp' say : "Feature Count: 3" After a "save as" on this layer, the file becomes good, we have 2 features in the .shp. On linux and QGIS 2.12.0, there is no problem.
