| <p>I have tried both 32 and 64 bit versions of the latest release level (2.12.2), plus the 64-bit version of 2.8 LTR. All of them show a fleeting message about "file locked" during installation with no further detail. At startup, they all crash into the Windows error dialog just after "Initializing GUI" appears on the splash box.</p> | | |
