I'm having a problem doing any of the following

- Saving edits to existing .shp files
- Converting other file types to .shp files

All other conversions appear to be working fine, but I am unable to save anything as a shape file. I have tried this on multiple versions (2.8.6 and 2.12.3, both 32 and 64 bit installs). I'm working on a 64bit Windows 7 machine.
