<p>Attempting to update 2.8.6-&gt;2.8.7 on Debian Wheezy fails because libjs-leaflet is required &amp; is not in repository. Workround is to download from Debian Sid &amp; install manually. Suggest adding it to <a href="http://qgis.org/debian-ltr">http://qgis.org/debian-ltr</a> wheezy main</p> <p>NOTE: I have had to set the affected version to 2.8.5 because this is the latest version on the drop-down list. The list is now 2(TWO) versions out of date!</p>
