Description In 2.14, a dataset extend change as a result of saving feature edits fails to update (cached?) layer extend. Steps to reproduce <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Create a new project2. Add the attached box shapefile dataset, and switch edit on3. Zoom out of a few steps, and enlarge the square-ish polygon already present4. Save the changes and switch edit off5. Right click on the layer, and select "zoom to layer"6. You'll notice it actually zooms to the extend of the layer <i>prior</i> to the edits you just saved
