steps to reproduce

- 1. Launch a fresh QGIS session
- 2. Add a vector layer
- 3. Open the labelling property window, go to the background panel
- 4. Enable background, select SVG type, and open the svg picker widget using the "..." button
- 5. Notice the border for previewed svgs isn't drawn (or probably more accurately is drawn with a stroke value set to 0)
