<p>When I edit a layer while a definition query is applied and then change the definition query to a different feature, I need to restart QGIS before I can use the edit node tool. I'm assuming this has something to do with the editor only indexing nodes on the first definition query.</p> <p>In order to recreate the problem edit one feature on a layer with a definition query applied. Save your edits and stop editing session. Then change the query to a different feature and start a new editing session. It will return the error "Node tool: could not snap to a segment on the current layer."</p> <p>I am running QGIS 2.10.1 64bit on 64bit Windows 7</p>
