<p>Hi</p> <p>I discovered that QGIS has trouble exporting table data via the clipboard. Steps:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Open a table from the layer list</li><li>2. Select all</li><li>3. Copy</li><li>4. Open Excel or a text editor</li><li>5. Paste there</li></ol> <p>The result is the correct number of rows, but all of them containing data from just the first row.</p> <p>QGIS 2.14.0, 64 bit Windows 7, 64 bit</p>
