<p>After looking into #11187</p> <p>It looks like the version number is not taken into account by the decision which plugin is the latest and should be loaded.</p> <p>In this case:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- a newer version (2.12.99) version of processing in \$INSTALL/share/qgis/python/plugins/and- a (repo) version 2.12.2 in .qgis2/python/plugins/ <p>is hidden.</p> <p>BUT given the setup above and starting QGIS 2.14, THEN QGIS works ok (aka is loading the 2.12.99 version and showing the menu's)</p> <p>So it looks like something is changed in master that breaks the version checking?</p>
