<p>Hi</p> <p>First issue:</p> <p>While Save a Raster As a GeoTiff</p> <p>Choosing Rendered Image and VRT</p> <p>Browse for filename you have to choose a folder. In the dialog the folder are named with an extension '.tif'</p> <p>This result in a new folder with the images, and the chosen folder is empty.</p> <p>Solution: Just remove the '.tif' manually</p> <p>If you don't choose the VRT everything is OK</p> <p>Second issue:</p> <p>Saving in the original pixelsize. The saved image are placed incorrect. Just a few meters north. If changing resolution from 0,1 to 0,2 the incorrect placement direction is headed North East.</p> <p>Regards</p> <p>Lene Fischer</p>
