<p>If the qgisRelation property of the QgsRelationEditorWidget is not defined correctly in the .ui file then opening a custom attribute form with a value relation widget causes QGIS crashes. This does not happen in 2.8.9 but does happen in 2.14.3 and master.</p> <p>I have only tested this on Windows 7, using OSGeo4W 64-bit.</p> <p>This is possibly related to bug report #14956.</p>
