<b>Description</b>		
<p>When a single action is defined for a layer, activating the action tool via the toolbar's "Run Feature Action" button should automatically activate that action. The current behavior, which activates no action, is IMO broken behavior.</p>		
<b>Steps to reproduce:</b>		
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Launch QGIS</li><li>2. Load a project file containing a layer with a pre-defined action (for the sake of this demonstration, many actions would do too)</li><li>3. Activate that layer</li><li>4. Click on the "Run Feature Action" toolbar button</li><li>5. Click on a feature from that layer, notice no action is happening</li></ol>
