<p>Toggle to edition a line or polygon temporary layer</p> <p>Try to add new feature using one of the "Add circular string..." tools.</p> <p>When validating your geometry, it's cleared. If you combined with the simple "add feature" tool when constructing the geometry, the curved part is modified to a straight line and sometimes QGIS may complain about a self-intersection (generated by its own modification)</p> <p>I think that, if it's normal that temporary layer doesn't allow supports curves then these circular tools should not be available. And more generally, if provider doesn't support curves, better disable the tools.</p>
