Hello, I try to utiiser "virtual layer" with an encoded layer 'latin1'. I want to change the value of an attribute of a single record. I write this for a fairly simple query : <pre>SELECT ROWID id, "INSEE_COM", "NOM_COM", CASE WHEN "INSEE_COM"='14118' THEN 'Préfecture de département' ELSE "STATUT" END AS STATUT, geometry FROM "COMMUNE" WHERE "CODE_DEPT"='14'</pre> It works well, but the result is encoded in ' latin1 ' when the change was made probably in utf8 (cf. image)
