<p>In the attribute table one can pick a sort column or expression.</p> <p>For widgets that have a display value, it would be more useful if the sort order would be by display value instead of the raw numeric value stored in the data provider.</p> <p>Affected widgets:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Value relation widget</li><li>- Relation reference widget</li><li>- Value map widget</li></ul> <p>I think it doesn't apply to date/time widgets, as these are sorted by the raw value, regardless of the display value.</p>
