<p>The load min / max values widget registers a static extent value, which was fine when it was part of a modal dialog but not so when part of the non-blocking style dock.</p> <p>The solution would be to pass onto the widget a reference to the map canvas element to dynamically retrieve the extent upon click on the [ Load ] button.</p>
