The file example.zip contains two tables. The table good\_col.sql creates a table public.test and was created by QGIS. At this table everything works fine. The other table bad\_col.sql will create a table public.geotope. This table was created by shp2pgsql and later some columns were added. At this table the content of the last column is missing.
