<p>Running SAGA modules in the Processing toolbox, I constantly get the following error message:</p> <p>splittext() takes exactly 1 argument (0 given) See log for more details</p> <p>Unfortunately the log file does not output any hints.</p> <p>This applies to 2.14.4 32bit and 34bit Windows standalone installer versions of QGIS. Strangly, the same files work with QGIS 2.16.0 on the same PC, and QGIS 2.14.1 on another.</p> <p>BTW the bug tracker does not allow to enter 2.14.4.
