### Unused mouse clicks could toggle layer on and off when panning

<b>Description</b>  With Pan Map activated, (hand shaped cursor), the user wishes to pan the map, toggle top layer off, pan the map, toggle top layer back on, ...  Currently he must move the mouse off the map, to Layers panel, center the mouse upon the layer's checkbox and click for each toggle.  It would be more helpful to allow the right click, or any other unused mouse action, to do this. Hopefully immediately without going into menus either.  That you might want to put more choices on the right click than just "wasting it" for only "toggle layer on/off", could be configurable.
