<p>In vector layer properties &gt; Display, once you chose a field to use for map tip and apply, there seems to not be a way to deactivate it, except turning off the map tip tool itself. This solution is not the best one given that you can have many layers for which you have activated the map tip and just want to remove one of them.</p>
