<p>The QGIS-Plugin-Manager seems to have a bug. After installing python plugins there is no icon available in the plugin description:</p> <p>https://i.stack.imgur.com/g9b7H.png</p> <p>Instead of the proper icon there is a placeholder displayed for each python plugin:</p> <p>https://i.stack.imgur.com/poWRF.png</p> <p>I copied the path to the image</p> <p>https://i.stack.imgur.com/czxSL.png</p> <p>--</p> <p>wich is:</p> <p><code>file://c:/Users/myusername/.qgis2/python/plugins/DigitizingTools/digitizingtools.png</code></p> <p>It seems as if the path would only work for unix filesystems as there is no colon after the drive letter.</p> <p>wrong path:</p> <p><code>c:/Users/myusername/.qgis2/python/plugins/DigitizingTools/digitizingtools.png</code></p> <p>correct path:</p> <p><code>C:\\Users\\myusername\\.qgis2\\python\\plugins\\DigitizingTools\\digitizingtools.png</code></p> <p>For C++-Plugins the icons are displayed:</p> <p>https://i.stack.imgur.com/fi5u6.png</p> <p>For the C++ plugins the resource path is used:</p> <p><code>qrc:/heatmap/heatmap.png</code></p> <p>Is this a known bug?</p>
