Description It would be nice if we could have a status indicator when loading a qgis-project. Some of my project have 20+ layers and when loading such a project, QGIS seems to do nothing for a couple seconds (up to half a minute). Some of my users then think that the program hangs or crashed. I think it would be great to have some sort of indication of what QGIS is doing while loading a project, telling the user which dataset it is currently loading, rendering or working on: Some of the options: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Write a message in the statusbar to indicate which layer qgis is currently working on- a dialogue displaying the progress- a progress bar (either in status bar or separate dialogue)- a list of layers to load and a status indicator to tell which layer is already loaded and which layers are still pending Thanks for considering to deal with this enhancement!
