<p>What does the projection capture selection button do?</p> <p>The only effect it seems to have is:</p> <p>a) if set a geographic coordinate system (any), lat/long are shown in that field</p> <p>b) if set to a project coordinate system, the same values as in the unprojected field below are shown</p> <p>c) if the same projection as the map is chosen, an error occurs.</p>

Are you sure the layer CRS is properly declared and reprojection on the fly is enabled? Why not to set the project CRS to match the layer CRS?

- a) Because geographic CS work in lat/long?
