<p>Layer properties --> Diagram --> Histogram</p> <p>In some situations, you may not have values for a field being classified (NULL) or these values do not match what you want to show (eg, using an expression-based field _case when "myfield"> 10 then "myfield" end). In these case, QGIS will draw an empty place (horizontal line) for the concerned field.</p> <p>It could be nice if instead of showing these "holes", there was an option to hide them and have a more compact histogram with only "valid" fields.</p>
