<p>Select a layer (i use the airports.shp of the qgis sample data)</p> <p>Add default actions in the layer properties and enable them in the attribute</p> <p>In the attribute table: while a "Actions" column is added at the end of the table with the enabled actions, the first column "ID" also displays these actions which therefore hide the real content of this column</p> <p>Sometimes you need to resize the column width to have this artifact appear</p> <p>Then, if you uncheck the "Actions widget" in the Organize columns dialog, the Actions column is removed but not the actions in the first column until you close that attribute table dialog</p> <p>QGIS 2.18.2 and master</p>
