<p>Add a point layer</p> <p>In layer styling (I live update activated though not sure it has something to do with the issue), Symbology, single symbol</p> <p>At the Marker level, use the "Assistant.." to modify the size of symbols</p> <p>Now select the "simple marker" level and click on the data-defined override icon (which should be yellow) near the Size option</p> <p>The yellow color disappear and the data-defined effects removed from the map canvas. This happens also if you select the Size option from the Marker level.</p> <p>Note however that the settings you entered in the Symbol Size dialog are still present.</p> <p>I don't know if it's due to this issue but I couldn't figure out how the Assistant could be ignored later in the settings.</p> <p>Master 3496871</p>
