Open a batch process dialog</li><li>2. Add multiple lines</li><li>3. Select the top line</li><li>4. Click the button to remove a line</li></ol> <p>What happens:</p> <p>The last line in the batch process is removed.</p> <p>What should happen:</p> <p>The line that is selected is removed.</p> |                 |   |
