<p>Hi</p> <p>with qgis-server 2.18.7, a GetMap with pdf output format is wrong if a WMS layer is in the list. If I use a WMS Layer as baselayer with full opacity, it hides all other layers in the pdf.</p> <p>The problem is not present with qgis-server 2.14.</p> <p>Regards</p> <p>Lionel</p>
