<p>The shear values in the transform effect on features are not being save with the project, and are not copied when the user duplicate the layer or copy/paste the style.</p> <p>To reproduce, in a Point layer do:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- style the layer with a SVG Marker with a large size (to be visible);- Add draw effects at symbol layer level;- Apply a Transform effect that includes Shear values (see screenshoot) <p>Things to try:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Duplicate the layer, the style will be changed not taking the shear values- Try copy past the style, it wont work either- Save the project, and open it again. The effect of the original layer will also not include the shrear values. <p>this is affecting 2.18 and master</p>
