<b>Description</b>		
<p>From the contextual menu of the input area, you can choose to save the command history. Hitting Save shows a "History saved" message (without knowing where it's saved)</p> <p>Worse, clicking the Save button from the commands history dialog (opened using Ctrl+Shift+Space), nothing is done. Hence no idea if it works or not.</p> <p>Could be nice to have message (message bar?) saying that it's saved and where (default place is ~/.qgis2/console_history.txt but i guess in customized profile, the folder is not the same)</p>
