<p>It seems like a click on the "New File" button (actually when you set the new file name), the function that is currently "selected" will be reset!</p> <p>By this I mean any edited code will be erased and replaced with the default startup code.</p> <p>There doesn't seem to be a way to undo this, so if you have written a lot of code in a function that has been reset, the code will be lost.</p> <p>The workaround is to create a "dummy" function that I select before I add a new file.</p> <p>Example:</p> <p>Skärmbild_2017-06-25_09-34-04.png</p> <p>Add new file, name it, press ok:</p> <p>Skärmbild_2017-06-25_09-35-04.png</p>
