<p>[[QgsVectorFileWriter]] allows to create case sensitive fields like 'foo' and 'FOO' in one table, but values of both attributes are written to the first case-insensitively-found field:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Create a new layer with two attributes like 'foo' and 'Foo' and add some features2. Save it as a new layer: menu Layer -> Save as shapefile3. The new layer's table contains corrupted data <p>It also doesn't respect the field width - see also #1664</p>
