All guys from our mapping dept use this all the time. Like when you duplicate layer for technical purposes, label it with some expr/attribute to quickly see whats inside all of the features and style the main one. Going through info or attribute table one-by-one is way slower.

You need to switch on/off often and fast to hide technical info (labels). This is on top of our wish list. ArcGIS has this in layer menu from version 8.0 or smth
