It seems either your PyQt4 installation doesn't provide the QtWebKit module at all, or it does, but under different path than the default PyQt4.QtWebKit. You didn't tell much about your operating system, but please ensure you don't need to install an additional package (like python-qt4-qtwebkit or so) in your package manager.

Please note QGIS 1.8 is very outdated now and not supported for years. The same with Sextante.
