| <p>Zooming to this new bookmark shows a much different extent on the map.</p> <p>Examining the x, y values in the bookmarks panel shows that xMax and yMin values are interchanged. Manually exchanging these two values fixes the bookmark.</p> <p>Imported bookmarks (exported from QGIS 2.14) are OK.</p> <p>Examining qgsbookmarks.cpp I find that the insert query (in two locations) has a different order for the column list vs. the parameter list, specifically xmax and ymin.</p> <p>This is a regression from 2.18.</p> <p>I am using OSGeo4W nightly build on Windows 8.1 64-bit system.</p> | | |
