<b>Description</b>		
<p>Hi,</p> <p>The scale bar has alignment problems. If one chooses "left", "centered" or "right", it is always left.</p> <p>If the zoom of the map is changed, the scale bar does not stay in place. It must always reposition it afterwards, which is a real waste of time.</p> <p>The alignment should be centered on the bar rather than the values and there is the possibility of writing the type of units below the middle.</p> <p>It would be very appreciated that regardless of the zoom chosen for the map that the scale bar always remains in the same place, well centered.</p>
