<p>I'm not sure this should be categorized as a bug or just a feature request.</p> <p>from a closed feature request: #10323 copy/paste style for multiple layers</p> <p>It seems that this got implemented only through tree view menu (right-click)</p> <p>But when using menu "Layer / Paste Style", it only pastes on the latest select layer, and if you select a group, Paste command is just grayed out.</p> <p>If the menu command also works, you will be able to just map a keyboard shortcut to Paste on multiple selected or group selected. That would be awesome.</p> <p>Thank you.</p>
