<p>Hi, I discovered a problem with QGIS (1.0.2 and 1.1). It's slow when zooming big vector layers (either in SHP and Postgis format).</p> <p>Reproduce it with:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) zoom in to a small region</li><li>2) zoom in another time</li></ol> <p>as you can see, QGIS is going to use 100% CPU and remains stuck.</p> <p>I've attached the shapefile in this URL, so you can test this:</p> <p><a href="http://webapps.comune.trento.it/base/zone.7z">[http://webapps.comune.trento.it/base/zone.7z]</a></p>
