<p>Qgis crashes when trying to remove fields from the table on layer created with "Join attributes by location".</p> <p>Steps to reproduce:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Load 2 layers and run "Join attributes by location" algorithm on them.</li><li>2. Make created joined layer editable and open attribute table.</li><li>3. Try to delete few fields from a table.</li><li>4. Qgis crashes.</li></ol> <p>Backtrace is provided in the attachment.</p>
