<p>When the help system fails to find a working page the user gets:</p> <div><p><i>QGIS help is currently not available. This is likely because:</i></p><ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>No internet connection is available</i><i>The offline help files are not available or the location of these files is not properly configured</i><i>No help content is available for the requested topic</i><p><i>Please check that the correct location of the offline help files is specified in the QGIS options dialog (Settings → Options → System).</i></p></div> <p>Maybe, the error message could show the last link it tried to open and couldn't find: it will help the user know if the error is local (URL badly constructed for example) or upstream (for example, some issues with docs site (redirection?)). See #17665.</p>
