<p>Add an ability to render labels beneath features of subsequent layers.</p> <p>This technique is often used in administrative maps etc. so it'd be of use to many qgis users imho.</p> <p>Right now a workaround is by having two or more overlapping maps in a composer, but that's hardly convenient and doesn't work for qgis server maps.</p> <p>This checkbox (Render labels on a layer level) could sit nicely beside label priority slider in label options dialog:)</p>
