In 2.18.15, you have the fields available and filled.</p> <p>This occurs also when you choose a "New vector layer" as destination; you'll notice in the "Save Vector Layer as..." dialog that the fields section is empty!</p> <p>PS: I'm not sure of the selected category</p>
