<p>We have a project with rotated symbols (data-defined rotation). In QGIS 2.99, when I click on them using the info tool, the red rubber band is shown wrongly, namely without rotation, so that it does not overlay the symbol itself.</p> <p>This still worked correctly in QGIS 2.18.</p> <p>(I'm not sure whether I chose the correct category, please change it if necessary!)</p>
