<p>I have a graduated layer style and would like to switch this to rule-based for usage in the atlas.</p> <p>When I add a new rule, which should represent the parent rule of the already existing ones from the graduated style, it is positioned below the current rule.</p> <p>I fail to drag it above, or drag those other rules below it, forming a rule tree.</p> <p>The mouse gets stuck and I can only go on by hitting ESC</p> <p>As there are no buttons for up/down, indent/outdent, the process fully relies on mouse actions, which unfortunately fail at my machine.</p>
