<div>Description</div> <div>The kind of thing I'm thinking is after records are updated...</div> <div><div>- Flash cells that have changed in the Attribute Table, say 5 seconds or something.</div><div>- Flash geometries on the main map (like the already existing "Flash feature"), say 5 seconds or something.</div><div>- Display in the main window an updated status message.</div><div>- Display in the Attribute Table some status message (in title bar?) indicating how many records were last updated.</div></div> <div>Basically just better feedback to the user that the changes intended were actually the changes that happened.</div>
