Description

The kind of thing I'm thinking is after records are updated...

- Flash cells that have changed in the Attribute Table, say 5 seconds or something.
- Flash geometries on the main map (like the already existing "Flash feature"), say 5 seconds or something.
- Display in the main window an updated status message.
- Display in the Attribute Table some status message (in title bar?) indicating how many records were last updated.

Basically just better feedback to the user that the changes **intended** were actually the changes that happened.
