Hi, On Windows 7 Professional 64 bit, QGIS 2.18.16 exporting to PDF, crashes with an composer layout with one map rotated to 270 degrees. The problem doesn't occur if I set it to 269.99°. Maybe a division by zero bug?

I've attached a project file that demonstrates the bug. Open the project, open the included composer layout, try to export to PDF ... baaam!

p.s. works in Fedora 27 Linux, but not in Windows 7 64 bit.

p.s. Furthermore, this project is very slow to load. I note that QGIS is stalling at "Loading composer...". What is it doing?
